

IN HOME WIFI NETWORK FACT #5

A wired connection to your modem is always stronger than the modem's WiFi signal. If you need maximum speed to a particular device (especially common for gaming units, smart televisions, or other video streaming devices), you may wish to connect directly to the modem instead of relying upon the modem's WiFi signal.

IN HOME WIFI NETWORK FACT #6

Modem location matters! Many times, walls, glass, or microwave ovens interfere, and thus weaken, the WiFi signal from the modem. Often, simply relocating the modem to a more optimal location in your home can make a difference in your online experience. Copper Valley Telecom technicians can generate a signal map (also called a "heat map") that shows each customer where their signal is strong or weak and where the best location is for the modem.
